- (a) To qualify for a license, an applicant and the hospice care program and its medical director shall meet the requirements of this section.
- (b) An applicant who is an individual, and any individual who is applying on behalf of a corporation, association, or government agency shall be:
  - (1) At least 18 years old; and
  - (2) Of reputable and responsible character.
- (c) (1) Except for a limited licensee, the applicant shall have a certificate of need, as required under Subtitle 1 of this title, for the hospice care program to be operated.
- (2) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT GRANT A PERSON THAT OPERATES A HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM:
  - (I) A STATEWIDE CERTIFICATE OF NEED; OR
- (II) AUTHORITY TO OPERATE THE HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM STATEWIDE THROUGH A COMMISSION RULING OR DETERMINATION.
- (3) A PERSON WHO ACQUIRES OR PURCHASES A GENERAL HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM AND WHO IS AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION TO OPERATE THE PROGRAM ON A STATEWIDE BASIS PRIOR TO MARCH 1, 2003, MAY ONLY SERVE:
- (I) RESIDENTS OF ANY JURISDICTION IN WHICH SERVICES WERE PROVIDED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2001; AND
- (II) RESIDENTS OF OTHER JURISDICTIONS WHO ARE DISCHARGED, IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE DELIVERY OF HOSPICE CARE SERVICES, FROM THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY THAT ORIGINALLY OPERATED THE GENERAL HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM.
- (4) A PERSON-WHO ACQUIRES OR PURCHASES A CENERAL HOSPICE CARE PROGRAM THAT WAS AUTHORIZED BY THE COMMISSION TO OPERATE ON A STATEWIDE BASIS PRIOR TO MARCH 1, 2003, MAY ONLY SERVE:
- (I) RESIDENTS OF ANY JURISDICTION IN WHICH SERVICES WERE PROVIDED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2001; AND
- (II) RESIDENTS OF OTHER JURISDICTIONS WHO ARE DISCHARGED, IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE DELIVERY OF HOSPICE CARE SERVICES, FROM THE HEALTH CARE FACILITY THAT ORIGINALLY OPERATED THE GENERAL HOSPICE CARE PROCRAM.
