## **CHAPTER 410**

(House Bill 156)

## Calvert County - Property Tax Credit - Members of Volunteer Fire and Rescue Companies

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of Calvert County to grant, by law, a tax credit against the county property tax imposed on real property that is owned by members of <u>volunteer</u> fire and rescue companies; authorizing the governing body of Calvert County to provide, by law, for the amount, duration, and criteria for qualifying for the tax credit under this Act; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to a local property tax credit in Calvert County for members of <u>volunteer</u> fire and rescue companies.

- $^{(F)}$  (1) THE GOVERNING BODY OF CALVERT COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY MEMBERS OF <u>VOLUNTEER</u> FIRE AND RESCUE COMPANIES.
