- (A) TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
  - (B) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.
  - (C) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.
- (D) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE OR HAVE COMPLETED EQUIVALENT EDUCATION AND HAVE COMPLETED SATISFACTORILY:
