

(2) obtain or attempt to obtain a controlled dangerous substance, or procure or attempt to procure the administration of a controlled dangerous substance by:

- (i) fraud, deceit, misrepresentation, or subterfuge;
- (ii) the counterfeiting or alteration of a prescription or a written order;
- (iii) the concealment of a material fact;
- (iv) the use of a false name or address;
- (v) falsely assuming the title of or representing to be a manufacturer, distributor, or authorized provider; or
- (vi) making, issuing, or presenting a false or counterfeit prescription or written order.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "ADEQUATE SUPPLY" MEANS AN AMOUNT OF MARIJUANA COLLECTIVELY POSSESSED BY A PARTICIPATING PATIENT AND THE PARTICIPATING PATIENT'S PRIMARY CAREGIVER THAT:

(i) IS NOT MORE THAN IS REASONABLY NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE UNINTERRUPTED AVAILABILITY OF MARIJUANA FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLEVIATING THE SYMPTOMS OR EFFECTS OF A PARTICIPATING PATIENT'S DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION; AND

(ii) DOES NOT EXCEED THREE MATURE MARIJUANA PLANTS, FOUR IMMATURE MARIJUANA PLANTS, AND 1 OUNCE OF USABLE MARIJUANA PER EACH MATURE PLANT.

(3) "DEBILITATING MEDICAL CONDITION" MEANS:

(i) CANCER, GLAUCOMA, POSITIVE STATUS FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS, ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY SYNDROME, OR THE TREATMENT OF THESE CONDITIONS;

(ii) A CHRONIC OR DEBILITATING DISEASE OR MEDICAL CONDITION, OR ITS TREATMENT, THAT PRODUCES ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. CACHEXIA OR WASTING SYNDROME, SEVERE PAIN, OR SEVERE NAUSEA; OR

2. SEVERE AND PERSISTENT MUSCLE SPASMS, INCLUDING THOSE THAT ARE CHARACTERISTIC OF MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS OR CROHN'S DISEASE, OR
