enter certain premises to ensure compliance with certain laws, rules, and regulations; authorizing the Board to adopt an ordinance or resolution declaring a certain violation to be a certain civil infraction or a misdemeanor punishable by a certain term of imprisonment or fine or both; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to suspend or revoke certain licenses under certain circumstances; authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to impose certain taxes; establishing a Special Gaming Fund; specifying the nature, use, and contents of the Fund; requiring that the Board of County Commissioners annually make certain payments and allocations from the Fund; defining certain terms; and generally relating to paper gaming in Allegany County.

- (c) "Qualified organization" means:
 - (1) a volunteer fire company; or
 - (2) a bona fide:
 - (i) religious organization;
 - (ii) fraternal organization;
 - (iii) civic organization;
 - (iv) war veterans' organization; or
 - (v) charitable organization.
