AN ACT concerning

Election Law – Study Commission on Public Funding of Campaigns in Maryland – Sunset Extension

FOR the purpose of establishing a new termination date for the Study Commission on Public Funding of Campaigns in Maryland; altering the date by which the Commission must report its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislative changes, to the Governor and the General Assembly; making a stylistic change; and generally relating to an extension of the sunset for the Study Commission on Public Funding of Campaigns in Maryland.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 169 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002
 Section 1 and 2

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
