(A) TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(B) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.

(C) THE APPLICANT SHALL BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

(D) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE A HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE OR HAVE COMPLETED EQUIVALENT EDUCATION AND HAVE COMPLETED SATISFACTORILY:

(1) AN ELECTROLOGY EDUCATION PROGRAM, TAUGHT BY A LICENSED ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR, THAT INCLUDES AT LEAST 600 HOURS OF INSTRUCTION, AND HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD; ~~OR AND THAT INCLUDES:~~
