(A) TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD:

(I) AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES;
AND

(II) EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 8-6B-08 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) PAY TO THE BOARD ~~AN EXAMINATION~~ A FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8-6B-10.

(A) AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) (1) THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.

(2) THE BOARD MAY GIVE REEXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS WHO FAIL ALL OR PART OF THE EXAMINATION AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.

(C) THE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

(D) ~~(1)~~ EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE SUBJECTS, SCOPE, FORM, AND PASSING SCORE FOR EXAMINATIONS GIVEN UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
