- (3) PASS THE ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR AN EXAMINATION APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND
- (4) MEET ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD UNDER § 8–6B–03 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

 - (A) TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:
 - (1) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD:

- (II) EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF \S 8–6B–08 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

- (A) AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION
- (B) (1) THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.
- (2) THE BOARD MAY GIVE REEXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS WHO FAIL ALL OR PART OF THE EXAMINATION AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.
- (C) THE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.
