

(2) AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS TWO REEXAMINATIONS MAY RETAKE THE EXAMINATION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

- (I) RETAKES THE ENTIRE EXAMINATION;
- (II) PAYS THE FULL EXAMINATION FEE; AND
- (III) COMPLETES AN EDUCATION PROGRAM THAT THE BOARD

REQUIRES.

8-6B-11.

(A) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE THE ~~THEORY SECTION OF THE~~ EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY IN ANOTHER STATE.

(B) THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

- (1) PAYS THE LICENSE FEE REQUIRED BY THE BOARD; AND
- (2) PROVIDES ADEQUATE EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT:

(I) MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE;

(II) BECAME LICENSED IN THE OTHER STATE AFTER PASSING IN THAT STATE, OR ANY OTHER STATE, AN EXAMINATION THAT IS SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO ~~THE AN~~ EXAMINATION ~~FOR WHICH THE APPLICANT IS SEEKING THE~~ WAIVER APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND

(III) BECAME LICENSED IN THE OTHER STATE AFTER MEETING REQUIREMENTS THAT ARE SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8-6B-12.

(A) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO:

- (1) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- (2) PAYS A LICENSE FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(B) THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH LICENSE THAT THE BOARD ISSUES A LICENSE DESIGNATION AS:

- (1) LICENSED ELECTROLOGIST; OR
- (2) LICENSED ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR.

8-6B-13.

(A) AN ELECTROLOGIST'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.
