prohibits trapshooting, skeetshooting, or other target shooting between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 p.m. by a shooting sports club that is chartered and in operation as of January 1, 2001.

- (ii) This paragraph does not apply in Allegany, Baltimore City, Calvert, Charles, Garrett, Howard, Montgomery, St. Mary's, and Washington counties.
 - (b) Each political subdivision [shall]:
- (1) [Send] SHALL SEND to the Department a copy of each noise control ordinance, rule, or regulation that it adopts; [and]
- (2) [Identify] SHALL IDENTIFY on each zoning map, comprehensive plan, or other appropriate document the sound level limits that are adopted under Subtitle 4 of this title; AND
 - (3) IS ENCOURAGED TO CONSIDER:
- (I) COMPLIANCE WITH STATE OR LOCAL NOISE STANDARDS BEFORE ACTING ON ANY PROPOSED VARIANCE REQUESTS OR CHANGES IN ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS; AND
- (II) WHETHER THE PERMIT OR ACTIVITY WILL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH LOCAL AND STATE NOISE CONTROL STANDARDS, PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING, ACTIVITY PERMIT, OR SIMILAR AUTHORIZING DOCUMENT.

There is an Environmental Noise Advisory Council in the Department. 3–202.

- (a) (1) The Council consists of [5] 11 members:
 - (I) 9 VOTING MEMBERS appointed by the Secretary; AND
 - (II) 2 EX OFFICIO MEMBERS.
 - (2) Of the [5] 11 Council members:
- (i) 1 shall be appointed from a list of at least 3 qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary by the Acoustical Society of America AND THE INSTITUTE OF NOISE CONTROL ENGINEERING:
- (ii) 1 shall be a physician who specializes in hearing, appointed from a list of at least 3 qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary by the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of the State of Maryland;
- (iii) 1 shall be appointed from a list of at least 3 qualified individuals submitted to the Secretary by the Chancellor of the University System of Maryland; [and]
 - (iv) 2 shall be appointed from the [general] public AT LARGE;
