(b) (C) A person may not engage in stalking.

(c) (D) A person who violates this section is guilty of a [misdemeanor] ~~FELONY~~ and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both.

(d) (E) A sentence imposed under this section may be separate from and consecutive to or concurrent with a sentence for any other crime based on the acts establishing a violation of this section.
