Preamble

WHEREAS, Many individuals with disabilities would like to work but cannot afford to enter the workforce because that would mean losing the necessary medical services they receive through Medicaid; and

WHEREAS, The federal Ticket to Work and Work Incentives Improvement Act allows states to establish new Medicaid eligibility categories for working people with disabilities whose income or resources would otherwise make them ineligible for Medicaid: now, therefore.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
