~~(a) (1) In addition to being subject to an injunctive action under this subtitle, a person who violates any provision of this subtitle or of any rule, regulation, order, or permit adopted or issued under this subtitle is liable to a civil penalty not exceeding [\$10,000] \$15,000, to be collected in a civil action brought by the Department.~~

~~(2) Each day a violation occurs is a separate violation under this subsection.~~

(a) Any person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor. Unless another penalty is specifically provided elsewhere in this title, the person, upon conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$500] ~~\$15,000~~ \$10,000, with costs imposed in the discretion of the court.

(b) Any person found guilty of a second or subsequent violation of any provision of this title, unless another penalty is specifically provided elsewhere in this title, is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$1,000] ~~\$30,000~~ \$25,000, or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year, or both with costs imposed in the discretion of the court. For the purpose of this subsection, a second or subsequent violation is a violation which has occurred within 2 years of any prior violation of this title.
