(v) A representative from the Office for Individuals with Disabilities, Office for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing;

(vi) Two members of the Board of Audiologists, Hearing Aid Dispensers and Speech-Language Pathologists, to include one audiologist and one speech-language pathologist;

(vii) A physician specializing in hearing health or children's health;
