

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 769 – Baltimore City – Pimlico Road Arts and Community Center Loan of 2001.

AN ACT concerning

**Baltimore City – Pimlico Road Arts and Community Center Loan of 2001**
