(2) A PRIVATE ENTITY THAT PROVIDES FIRE FIGHTING, POLICE, MEDICAL, OR OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.

(L) PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT

"PUBLIC SAFETY ANSWERING POINT" MEANS A COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY THAT:

- (1) IS OPERATED ON A 24-HOUR BASIS;
- (2) FIRST RECEIVES 9-1-1 CALLS IN A 9-1-1 SERVICE AREA; AND
- (3) AS APPROPRIATE, DISPATCHES PUBLIC SAFETY SERVICES DIRECTLY, OR TRANSFERS 9–1–1 CALLS TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES.

In item (2) of this subsection, the former reference to receiving 911 calls "from persons" in a 911 service area is deleted as surplusage.

(M) SECRETARY.

"SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

- (N) WIRELESS TELEPHONE SERVICE.
- (1) "WIRELESS TELEPHONE SERVICE" MEANS PUBLIC TELEPHONE SERVICE THAT:
  - (I) IS PROVIDED FOR TWO WAY VOICE OR DATA COMMUNICATION;
- (II) IS TRANSMITTED INDEPENDENTLY OF SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS TELEPHONE SERVICE; AND
- (III) MAY BE TRANSMITTED PARTLY VIA CABLE OR WIRE AS PART OF A LARGER TELEPHONE OR CABLE SYSTEM.
