- (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- (1) one member of the Maryland House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (2) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (3) the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs, or the Secretary's designee; and
 - (4) The Comptroller or the Comptroller's designee; and
 - (4) (5) the following members, appointed by the Governor:
 - (i) one representative from the American Legion;
 - (ii) one representative from the Veterans of Foreign Wars;
 - (iii) one representative from the Military Officers Association;
 - (iv) one representative from the Retired Enlisted Association;
 - (v) one representative who is a certified public accountant; and
 - (vi) three representatives from the general public.
 - (c) The Governor shall designate the chairman of the Task Force.
- (d) The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Legislative Services State Comptroller's Office shall provide staffing for the Task Force.
 - (e) A member of the Task Force:
 - (1) may not receive compensation; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (f) The Task Force shall determine:
- (1) <u>determine</u> the number of retired military service personnel in the <u>State of Maryland;</u>
- (2) <u>determine</u> the number of retired military service personnel engaged in a second career or secondary employment of any kind;
- (3) determine the average total income of retired military personnel including any secondary employment or secondary career income, military retirement income, or other retirement income;
- (4) determine the value of any additional benefits or programs available to retired military personnel;
