

(b) The Task Force consists of the following members:

(1) one member of the Maryland House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;

(2) one member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;

(3) the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs, or the Secretary's designee; and

(4) The Comptroller or the Comptroller's designee; and

~~(4)~~ (5) the following members, appointed by the Governor:

(i) one representative from the American Legion;

(ii) one representative from the Veterans of Foreign Wars;

(iii) one representative from the Military Officers Association;

(iv) one representative from the Retired Enlisted Association;

(v) one representative who is a certified public accountant; and

(vi) three representatives from the general public.

(c) The Governor shall designate the chairman of the Task Force.

(d) The Maryland Department of Veterans Affairs and the ~~Department of Legislative Services~~ State Comptroller's Office shall provide staffing for the Task Force.

(e) A member of the Task Force:

(1) may not receive compensation; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(f) The Task Force shall ~~determine~~:

(1) determine the number of retired military service personnel in the State of Maryland;

(2) determine the number of retired military service personnel engaged in a second career or secondary employment of any kind;

(3) determine the average total income of retired military personnel including any secondary employment or secondary career income, military retirement income, or other retirement income;

(4) determine the value of any additional benefits or programs available to retired military personnel;
