- [(3)] (4) The Governor shall appoint all members of the Board with the advice of the Secretary and the advice and consent of the Senate.
- [(4)] (5) The Governor shall appoint all social work members of the Board from a list of nominees containing names submitted by:
 - (i) Professional social work associations in the State;
- (ii) Any person who provides a statement of nomination signed by at least 25 social workers licensed in the State; or
- $\mbox{(iii)}$ The secretaries of public agencies of the State where social workers are employed.

- (a) (1) From among its members, the Board shall elect a chairman and a secretary every 2 years.
- (2) THE BOARD MAY ELECT OTHER OFFICERS AS NECESSARY TO FULFILL THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE BOARD.
 - (b) The Board shall determine:
- (1) The manner of election of the chairman, [and] secretary, AND OTHER OFFICERS; and
