A match obtained between an evidence sample and a data base entry may only be used as probable cause to obtain [a blood sample] AN ADDITIONAL DNA SAMPLE from the subject and is not admissible at trial unless confirmed by additional testing.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 4 of this Act, this Act shall take effect on October 1, 2002. [It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of September 30, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2003.

Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed House Bill 576 – Cecil County – Board of Education – Selection of Members.

This bill is intended to require that members of the Cecil County Board of Education be elected. Additionally, the bill establishes a procedure for the election of members of the Cecil County Board of Education, and sets a specified term of office for elected members. Finally, the bill submits the Act to a referendum vote of the legally qualified voters of Cecil County in November 2004, the question of whether to have an elected or appointed school board.

Senate Bill 518, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 576.
