## **Article - Education**

## SUBTITLE 4A. CECIL COUNTY.

3-4A-01.

- (A) THE CECIL COUNTY BOARD CONSISTS OF SIX MEMBERS AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) ONE VOTING MEMBER ELECTED FROM EACH OF THE FIVE COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS; AND
  - (2) ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER.
- (B) THE FIVE VOTING MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE ELECTED AT A GENERAL ELECTION AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- $(\mathrm{C})$   $\,$  (1)  $\,$  A MEMBER FROM A COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE DISTRICT.
- (2) A MEMBER FROM A COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT WHO NO LONGER RESIDES IN THE DISTRICT MAY NOT CONTINUE AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY BOARD.
- (3) A CANDIDATE ELECTED TO THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE A REGISTERED VOTER AND RESIDENT OF CECIL COUNTY FOR AT LEAST 3 YEARS.
- (4) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY BOARD AT THE TIME OF FILING IS INELIGIBLE TO BE A CANDIDATE.
- (II) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS A COUNTY EMPLOYEE OR THE SPOUSE OF A TEACHER AT THE TIME OF FILING IS INELIGIBLE TO BE A CANDIDATE.
- (D) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, EACH VOTING MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF 4 YEARS BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1 THE FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER AFTER THE MEMBER'S ELECTION AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (2)  $\stackrel{\text{(4)}}{\text{(4)}}$  A VOTING MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO TERMS.
