(2) REPORT THE FINDINGS TO THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 38A, § 46H.

In the introductory language of subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "[o]n or before" August 30 is substituted for the former reference to "by" August 30 for clarity and consistency with style in the revised articles of the Code.

In subsection (a)(1) through (3) of this section, the former phrase "during the fiscal year" is deleted as surplusage in light of the introductory language of subsection (a) of this section, which requires the report to include information for the previous fiscal year.

In subsection (a)(2) of this section, the reference to "each volunteer company" that received a loan is substituted for the former reference to the "entities" that received a loan because only volunteer companies receive loans under this subtitle.

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the word "money" is substituted for the former phrase "financial assistance" for consistency with terminology used throughout this subtitle.

Also in subsection (b)(1) of this section, the word "spent" is substituted for the former word "expended" for clarity.

The Public Safety Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that the reporting requirement only applies to loans, but grants may also be awarded under this subtitle. See § 8–204(g) of this subtitle. The absence of a reporting requirement for grants may be an oversight.

SUBTITLE 3. COUNTY MONEY AND LOANS FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES.

8-301. CONTRIBUTION OF MONEY TO VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES — IN GENERAL.

(A) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THE SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, BALTIMORE COUNTY, CECIL COUNTY, HOWARD COUNTY, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY, AND WORCESTER COUNTY.

(B) EXPRESS POWER.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF EACH COUNTY HAVE THE EXPRESS POWER TO CONTRIBUTE MONEY TO A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY IN THE COUNTY.
