(G) FIREWORKS PLANT.

(1) "FIREWORKS PLANT" MEANS LAND AND ANY BUILDING ON THE LAND USED IN CONNECTION WITH THE MANUFACTURE, PACKAGING, REPACKAGING, OR PROCESSING OF FIREWORKS.

(2) "FIREWORKS PLANT" INCLUDES A STORAGE BUILDING USED IN CONNECTION WITH PLANT OPERATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 38A, § 15(f).

In paragraph (1) of this subsection, the former reference to "all" lands is deleted as unnecessary.

Also in paragraph (1) of this subsection, the reference to buildings "used in connection with" is substituted for the former reference to buildings "used for or in connection with" for brevity. Similarly, in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the reference to a building "used in connection with" is substituted for the former reference to buildings "used with or in connection with".

(H) MIXING BUILDING.

"MIXING BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING PRIMARILY USED TO MIX AND BLEND PYROTECHNIC COMPOSITION OTHER THAN WET SPARKLER MIXES.

(I) PRESS BUILDING.

"PRESS BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING USED PRIMARILY FOR PRESSING OR LOADING PYROTECHNIC COMPOSITION INTO TUBES OR CONTAINERS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly was Art. 38A, § 15(h).

The reference to the defined term "pyrotechnic composition" is substituted for the former reference to pyrotechnic "powder" for consistency.
