OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF BOWIE BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ADJOINING TO THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE CITY OF BOWIE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY CONSISTING OF THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS OLDE STAGE KNOLLS, LOCATED GENERALLY ALONG OLDE STAGE ROAD BETWEEN THE RAILROAD TRACKS KNOWN AS THE COLLINGTON BRANCH LINE AND CHURCH ROAD, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 147.7470 ACRES
