**Resolution No. 225**

(CHARTER AMENDMENT: 2000 ANNEXATION 2nd ADDITION)

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ADJOINING THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE LOCATED BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERN CORNER OF I-95 AND MD STATE ROUTE 155 AND GENERALLY EXTENDING SOUTHERLY TO CHAPEL ROAD, AND CONSISTING OF 155.429 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE BARKER, ABEL, GREEN, ROUTE 155 LLC, STAMPER, AND SUE-EL PROPERTIES, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND AND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION AND AMENDMENTS THERETO) TITLED "CORPORATIONS-MUNICIPAL"; TO AMEND THE APPENDIX OF THE CHARTER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION A.18., ENTITLED "THE 2000 2nd ADDITION TO THE CITY BOUNDARIES", ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE.

**Resolution No. 237**

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION, 1998 REPLACEMENT VOLUME, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO) TITLED "CORPORATIONS-MUNICIPAL;" TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, BY AMENDING SECTION 37 THEREOF BY REQUIRING THE CITY COUNCIL TO SET THE CITY TAX RATES AND WATER AND SEWER RATES BY ORDINANCE ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST COUNCIL MEETING IN JUNE OF EACH YEAR.
