AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE AND EMPOWER THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO BORROW ON ITS FULL FAITH AND CREDIT, AND TO ISSUE AND SELL ITS GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND ITS BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES THEREFOR, AT ONE TIME OR FROM TIME TO TIME WITHIN FOUR YEARS FROM THE DATE THIS BILL BECOMES EFFECTIVE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$1,500,000 TO PROVIDE FINANCING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF A NEW SNOW HILL SENIOR CENTER AND ADULT MEDICAL DAY CARE CENTER
