Laws of Montgomery County, 2002

AN ACT to:

- (1) require notice to certain property owners or the posting of a certain sign before the Department of Permitting Services approves a permit to demolish $\underline{\underline{or}}$ remove a building or structure;
- (2) require [[notice to the Historic Preservation Commission and]] additional public notice if a building to be demolished is greater than a certain age; and
