**Emergency Bill No. 8-02**

**Chapter 22**

**Laws of Montgomery County, 2002**

AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (1) require a fire safety code inspection of certain schools at least once a year;
- (2) require reinspection soon after the deadline for correcting any serious fire safety violation;
- (3) generally amend County law regarding fire safety code inspections and enforcement.

AN EMERGENCY ACT to designate the position of Director of the *Go Montgomery!* Program as a non-merit position in the Department of Public Works and Transportation and specify the duties of the position.

**Bill No. 1-02**

**Chapter 24**

**Laws of Montgomery County, 2002**

AN ACT to:

(1) require notice to certain property owners or the posting of a certain sign before the Department of Permitting Services approves a permit to demolish or remove a building or structure;

(2) require [[notice to the Historic Preservation Commission and]] additional public notice if a building to be demolished is greater than a certain age; and
