

(I) FILED IN THE PERSONNEL RECORDS OF THE FIREWORKS PLANT; AND

(II) MADE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

(B) MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND OTHERS.

A LICENSEE SHALL POST CONSPICUOUSLY IN EACH BUILDING SIGNS STATING THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF WORKERS AND VISITORS WHO MAY BE PRESENT IN THE BUILDING AT ANY ONE TIME.

(C) CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT.

(1) A LICENSEE SHALL:

(I) PROVIDE COTTON WORKING UNIFORMS AND CONDUCTIVE SHOES TO EACH INDIVIDUAL WORKING IN A MIXING BUILDING AND PRESS BUILDING IN A FIREWORKS PLANT;

(II) PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR:

1. INDIVIDUALS TO CHANGE INTO AND OUT OF UNIFORMS;  
AND

2. THE SAFEKEEPING OF CLOTHING;

(III) WASH UNIFORMS FREQUENTLY TO PREVENT THE ACCUMULATION OF EXPLOSIVE COMPOSITION ON THE UNIFORMS; AND

(IV) PROVIDE FOR EMPLOYEES WASHING AND SHOWERING FACILITIES DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

(2) (I) EACH INDIVIDUAL WORKING IN A MIXING BUILDING AND PRESS BUILDING IN A FIREWORKS PLANT SHALL WEAR THE COTTON UNIFORMS AND CONDUCTIVE SHOES THAT THE LICENSEE PROVIDES.

(II) EACH INDIVIDUAL WORKING IN A PRODUCTION BUILDING IN A FIREWORKS PLANT SHALL WEAR THE TYPE OF EYE PROTECTION DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

(III) EACH INDIVIDUAL WORKING IN A MIXING AREA IN A FIREWORKS PLANT SHALL WEAR THE TYPE OF RESPIRATOR DESIGNATED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE.

(3) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT WEAR THE UNIFORM OUTSIDE THE FIREWORKS PLANT.

(D) USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON MAY NOT SMOKE OR CARRY A LIGHTED PIPE, CIGARETTE, CIGAR, MATCH, LIGHTER, OR OPEN FLAME INSIDE THE FENCE OF A FIREWORKS PLANT.
