FIREARMS SHALL PROVIDE PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT THAT THE STATE FIRE PREVENTION COMMISSION SETS.

(C) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR LICENSE TO POSSESS EXPLOSIVES.

IN ADDITION, AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO POSSESS EXPLOSIVES OTHER THAN EXPLOSIVES FOR USE IN FIREARMS SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- (1) THE PLACE WHERE THE EXPLOSIVES WILL BE STORED;
- (2) THE PLACE WHERE THE EXPLOSIVES WILL BE USED; AND
- (3) THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE FOR USING THE EXPLOSIVES.
- (D) WHERE TO SUBMIT APPLICATION.
- (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE TO POSSESS EXPLOSIVES OTHER THAN EXPLOSIVES FOR USE IN FIREARMS SHALL SUBMIT THE APPLICATION:
 - (I) TO THE LOCAL LICENSING AUTHORITY; OR
- (II) IF THE APPLICANT IS A NONRESIDENT OF THE STATE AND HAS NO REGULAR PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THE STATE, TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.
- (2) ALL OTHER APPLICANTS FOR LICENSES SHALL SUBMIT THE APPLICATION TO THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.
 - (E) FEES.
- (1) EACH APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING FEE:
