The Public Safety Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, the guidelines required by this section have never been developed and the advisory committee on energy conservation was never appointed.

SUBTITLE 3. INDUSTRIALIZED BUILDINGS AND MANUFACTURED HOMES. 12-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) DEPARTMENT.

"DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT.

No changes are made.

- (C) FIRST USER.
- (1) "FIRST USER" MEANS A PERSON WHO INITIALLY INSTALLS AN INDUSTRIALIZED BUILDING OR MANUFACTURED HOME IN THE STATE.
- (2) "FIRST USER" DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON WHO SUBSEQUENTLY BUYS A BUILDING THAT CONSISTS WHOLLY OR PARTLY OF AN INDUSTRIALIZED BUILDING.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 83B, § 6-202(c).

In paragraph (1) of this subsection, the references to an "industrialized building" and a "manufactured home" are substituted for the former reference to "factory-built buildings" for clarity. The types of factory-built buildings covered by this subtitle are industrialized buildings and manufactured homes.

Also in paragraph (1) of this subsection, the former references to a "firm" and a "corporation" are deleted as included in the defined term "person". See § 1-101 of this article.
