

"AUTHORIZED ELECTRICAL INSPECTION AGENCY" MEANS A NONGOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATION APPROVED BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL TO INSPECT ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS FOR CONFORMITY WITH THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE OR A LOCAL CODE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly was Art. 38A, § 59(a)(2).

The reference to a "nongovernmental" organization is added for clarity.

(C) ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION.

"ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION" MEANS ANY INSTALLED:

(1) ELECTRICAL WIRES OR CONDUCTORS THAT TRANSMIT ELECTRIC CURRENT FOR ELECTRIC LIGHT, HEAT, OR POWER PURPOSES;

(2) MOLDING, DUCT, RACEWAY, OR CONDUIT FOR THE RECEPTION OR PROTECTION OF WIRES OR CONDUCTORS; OR

(3) ELECTRICAL MACHINERY, APPARATUS, DEVICE, OR FIXTURE.

12-602. SCOPE OF SUBTITLE.

(A) COUNTIES EXEMPT FROM SUBTITLE.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO BALTIMORE COUNTY, CARROLL COUNTY, FREDERICK COUNTY, OR MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

(B) PUBLIC UTILITIES.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO PUBLIC UTILITIES, THEIR AFFILIATED COMPANIES, AND ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES AND DEVICES USED IN THEIR WORK.

12-603. ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION TO CONFORM TO CODE.

EACH ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION IN THE STATE SHALL CONFORM TO:

(1) THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE; OR

(2) THE ELECTRICAL CODE ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION IS DONE.
