(L) MOVING WALK.

(M) SAFETY CODE.

"SAFETY CODE" MEANS THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARD/AMERICAN SOCIETY OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERS SAFETY CODE FOR ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS, AND MOVING WALKS, KNOWN AS ANSI A17.1–1971, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS TO IT, AS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER.
