- (3) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

## 12-821. CHAIRMAN.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

(B) TIE VOTE.

THE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE THE DECIDING VOTE IF THERE IS A TIE VOTE BY THE BOARD.
