(B) MAXIMUM FEES.

THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FEES ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED, FOR THE 2–YEAR TERM OF THE LICENSE:

- (1) \$100 PER YEAR FOR AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC; AND
- (2) \$150 PER YEAR FOR AN ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR.

12-826. LICENSE REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS.

(A) ELEVATOR MECHANIC.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD AS AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC BEFORE THE PERSON ERECTS, CONSTRUCTS, WIRES, ALTERS, REPLACES, MAINTAINS, REPAIRS, DISMANTLES, OR SERVICES ELEVATOR UNITS IN THE STATE.

(B) ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD AS AN ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR BEFORE THE PERSON ENGAGES IN THE BUSINESS OF ERECTING, CONSTRUCTING, WIRING, ALTERING, REPLACING, MAINTAINING, REPAIRING, DISMANTLING, OR SERVICING ELEVATOR UNITS IN THE STATE.

(C) EXCEPTIONS.

(1) A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR IS NOT REQUIRED FOR REMOVING OR DISMANTLING AN ELEVATOR UNIT IF:
