12-832. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

(A) ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE.

WHILE AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ERECT, CONSTRUCT, WIRE, ALTER, REPLACE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, DISMANTLE, OR SERVICE ELEVATOR UNITS UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR.

(B) ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR LICENSE.

WHILE AN ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF ERECTING, CONSTRUCTING, WIRING, ALTERING, REPLACING, MAINTAINING, REPAIRING, DISMANTLING, OR SERVICING ELEVATOR UNITS.

12-833. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSE.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

(1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, UNLESS A LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE SECOND ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

(2) THE SECRETARY MAY DETERMINE THAT LICENSES ISSUED UNDER PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL EXPIRE ON A STAGGERED BASIS.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE, AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:

(1) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND

(2) A NOTICE THAT STATES:

(I) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;
