- (II) THE DATE BY WHICH THE BOARD MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND
  - (III) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
  - (C) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW THE LICENSE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2–YEAR TERM IF THE LICENSEE:

- (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;
- (2) PAYS THE RENEWAL FEE TO THE BOARD; AND
- (3) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES.
  - (D) CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY.

THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO:

- (1) REQUIRE A DEMONSTRATION OF CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY FOR A LICENSEE AS A CONDITION OF RENEWAL OF A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION;
  - (2) ESTABLISH CRITERIA FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDERS;
- $\hspace{0.1in}$  (3) PROVIDE FOR A TEMPORARY WAIVER OF CONTINUING EDUCATION UNDER SPECIFIED CIRCUMSTANCES; AND
- (4) SET RECORD KEEPING CRITERIA FOR APPROVED CONTINUING EDUCATION PROVIDERS.
  - (E) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF AND ISSUE A RENEWAL CERTIFICATE TO EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
