SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

~~(s) (1) (i) In St. Mary's County the State's Attorney's salary is [90 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland] \$90,420. A salary increase shall take effect at the beginning of the elected term of office and may not increase during that term of office.~~

~~(ii) During his term of office, the State's Attorney may not engage in the private practice of law in any matter after December 31, 1982.~~
