(c) (1) Notwithstanding subsection (b) of this section, if a custodial parent applies for public assistance and has been convicted of a felony involving the possession, use, or distribution of a controlled dangerous substance since August 22, 1996, the custodial parent shall be subject to testing for substance abuse, as provided by the Department, and to treatment, as required under § 50A of this article, [in addition to the provisions of § 50A of this article] for a period of 2 years starting from the date of application, to the extent permissible by federal law.
