(b) (1) "Crime of violence" means:

- (i) murder in any degree;
- (ii) manslaughter;
- (iii) kidnapping;
- (iv) rape in any degree;
- (v) assault in the first degree;
- (vi) robbery under § 3-402 or § 3-403 of this article;
- (vii) burglary in any degree;
- (viii) escape in the first degree; [or]
- (ix) theft;

~~(X) AN ACT OF TERRORISM OR A THREAT TO COMMIT AN ACT OF TERRORISM UNDER § 3-1002 OR § 3-1003 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR~~
