~~(i) Of the size and design that the Administration requires; and~~

~~(ii) Tamperproof, to the extent possible.~~

~~(2) The card shall contain:~~

~~(i) The name and address of the applicant;~~

~~(ii) The birth date of the applicant;~~

~~(iii) The sex of the applicant;~~

~~(iv) A description of the applicant;~~

~~(v) A color photograph of the applicant taken by the procedure that the Administration requires;~~

~~(vi) The expiration date of the identification card;~~

~~(vii) The signature of the applicant; and~~

~~(viii) The signature and seal of the issuing agent.~~

~~(h) An identification card may be used as legal identification of the individual to whom it is issued for any purpose.~~

~~(i) [An identification card expires every 5 years. It may be renewed on application and payment of the fee required by this section.]~~

~~(1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD EXPIRES EVERY 5 YEARS.~~
