- (2) AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION TO A PERSON-WHO IS NOT A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES AND WHO POSSESSES A VALID FOREIGN PASSPORT WITH A VALID UNITED STATES VISA OR OTHER ENTRY DOCUMENT ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES IMMICRATION OR NATURALIZATION SERVICE SHALL EXPIRE ON THE EARLIER OF:
 - (I) 5 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUANCE; OR
- (II) THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE VISA OR OTHER ENTRY DOCUMENT AUTHORIZING THE PERSON'S PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES.
- (j) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CANCEL AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE IF THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES THAT THE HOLDER OF THE IDENTIFICATION CARD:
 - (I) WAS NOT ENTITLED TO BE ISSUED THE IDENTIFICATION CARD:
- (II) FAILED TO PROVIDE ACCURATE OR REQUIRED INFORMATION IN THE APPLICATION FOR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD:
- (III) FRAUDULENTLY APPLIED FOR OR OBTAINED THE IDENTIFICATION CARD; OR
- $\overline{\text{(IV)}}$ IS IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (C), (D), (E), OR (F) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) IF THE ADMINISTRATION CANCELS AN IDENTIFICATION CARD UNDER PARACRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE HOLDER OF THE IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL IMMEDIATELY SURRENDER THE CANCELED IDENTIFICATION CARD TO THE ADMINISTRATION.
- (K) The identification eard shall be surrendered by the holder upon being issued a Maryland driver's license.
