AN ACT concerning

Income Tax - Wage Lien - Excluded Amounts

FOR the purpose of altering the amount of salary, wages, or other compensation excluded from the wage lien for income tax; providing that the amount excluded from the wage lien for income tax is the amount exempt under a provision of law exempting certain wages from attachment; and generally relating to the exclusion of salary, wages, or other compensation from the wage lien for income tax.
