SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – State Government**

9–1803.

There is a Council on Management and Productivity in the Department of Budget and Management.

9–1804.

The Council consists of:

- (1) ~~thirteen~~ TEN individuals, including representatives of labor, local government, and nonprofit organizations, who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor;
- (2) ~~two members~~ ONE MEMBER of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (3) ~~two members~~ ONE MEMBER of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (4) ~~two representatives~~ ONE REPRESENTATIVE of the Judicial Branch, appointed by the Chief Judge of the Maryland Court of Appeals;
- (5) two representatives of the business community:
  - (i) one appointed by the President of the Senate of Maryland; and
  - (ii) one appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; and
