**CHAPTER 163**  
**(Senate Bill 456)**

AN ACT concerning

**State Board of Master Electricians - Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation**

FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Master Electricians in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; ~~requiring applicants for a State master electrician license or renewal of a State license to report the number and jurisdiction of all other master electrician licenses held by the applicant;~~ requiring local licensing jurisdictions to report to the State Board the initiation of disciplinary action against licensed master electricians within a certain time period; requiring the State Board to notify ~~certain~~ local licensing jurisdictions when the State Board is notified of a disciplinary action against a master electrician ~~holding licenses in certain jurisdictions;~~ requiring local licensing jurisdictions to submit an annual report to the State Board on the number of complaints against master electricians in the local jurisdiction on or before a certain date; requiring that an evaluation of the State Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the State Board be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the State Board to submit a certain report to certain committees on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board of Master Electricians.
