In addition to any other information that the Commission requires, the annual report of a public service company shall state:

(6) when applicable:

(i) [a monthly compilation of revenues collected as fuel rate adjustments under § 4-403 of this article;

(ii)] a monthly compilation of expenditures that were the basis for any fuel rate adjustment; and

[(iii)](II) an annual recapitulation of the information required under [subitems (i) and (ii)] SUBITEM (I) of this item.
