- (ii) has been found guilty of the crime of:

1. child abuse under [Article 27, § 35C of the Code] § 3-601 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; or

2. escape under [Article 27, § 137 of the Code] § 9-404 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

(d) (4) An inmate is not eligible for the home detention program if the inmate:

- (i) is serving a sentence for a crime of violence; or
- (ii) has been found guilty of the crime of:

1. child abuse under [Article 27, § 35C of the Code] § 3-601 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; or

2. escape under [Article 27, § 137 of the Code] § 9-404 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.

(p) A participant is not eligible for the home detention program if the participant:

- (2) has been found guilty of:

(i) child abuse under [Article 27, § 35C of the Code] § 3-601 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE; or

(ii) escape under [Article 27, § 137 of the Code] § 9-404 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.
