- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (c) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct. [13-504.] 13-507.

From among the members of the State Advisory Council, the Governor shall appoint a chairman for a 2-year term.

## **[13-505.]** 13-508.

- (a) A majority of the members then serving on the Advisory Council is a quorum.
  - (b) The Advisory Council shall determine the times and places of its meetings.
  - (c) A member of the Advisory Council:
    - (1) May not receive compensation; but
- (2) Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (d) The Secretary shall designate the staff necessary to carry out this subtitle. [13-506.] 13-509.

In addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this subtitle, the Advisory Council has the following powers and duties:

- (1) TO ADVISE THE DEPARTMENT ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAM:
- (2) TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROGRAM BY:
- [(1)] (I) [To study and to make recommendations for] RECOMMENDING an integrated State program of education and applied research in gerontology and geriatrics;
- [(2)](II) [To develop and coordinate] DEVELOPING AND COORDINATING programs in vocational rehabilitation and industry designed to assist individuals with arthritis to remain productive members of the State's workforce;
- [(3)](III) [To coordinate] COORDINATING the development of a strategic plan of patient education throughout the State, involving State and local health departments, private agencies, pharmaceutical companies, medical schools, and related professional organizations;
- [(4)](IV) [To address] ADDRESSING gaps in the delivery of State service and to make recommendations designed to contain costs associated with arthritis prevention, treatment, and vocational training;
