SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

6-301.

(q) (1) This subsection applies only in Montgomery County.

(8) (I) ~~THERE IS A CLASS C (CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY) BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR~~ CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY LICENSE.

(II) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$500.

(III) ~~THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A LICENSE ONLY FOR USE BY~~ LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A CLUB THAT:

1. IS COMPOSED OF RESIDENTS OF A CONTINUING CARE RETIREMENT COMMUNITY THAT HAS OBTAINED A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGING UNDER ARTICLE 70B, § 11 OF THE CODE;

2. HAS AT LEAST 50 BONA FIDE MEMBERS; AND

3. HAS ANNUAL DUES THAT AVERAGE AT LEAST \$5 PER MEMBER.

(IV) ~~A LICENSEE MAY KEEP FOR SALE AND SELL AT RETAIL TO ANY CUSTOMER A MEMBER OR A GUEST WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR, PURCHASED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE LICENSED PREMISES ONLY.~~

~~(V) A LICENSE APPLICATION SHALL BE SIGNED BY AT LEAST ONE OFFICER OF THE CLUB WHO IS A RESIDENT OF, REGISTERED VOTER IN, OR TAXPAYER OF THE COUNTY.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
